Mission Statement

Aim

- To minimise or eliminate adverse impacts on the environment both local and global in our activities both within and outside Seagrove Pavilion

Objectives

Seagrove Pavilion Trust shall:

- Maintain respect for natural resources by ensuring the most efficient use of materials and by using renewable, recycled and recyclable products wherever possible.
- Ensure the use of environmentally friendly products where possible and avoid the use of environmentally exploitative products such as peat or tropical hardwoods
- Adopt and communicate the principles of reducing, reusing or recycling waste materials.
- Dispose of all wastes through safe and responsible methods in compliance with the relevant environmental legislation.
- Ensure the responsible use of energy by conserving energy, improving energy efficiency seeking to utilise safer energy sources and giving preference to renewable over finite energy resources wherever possible
- Minimise water consumption by installing appropriate equipment and communicate the importance of water conservation.
- Where appropriate purchase goods, services and materials locally
- Ensure any ecologically important species in the locality are conserved and, where possible, enhanced.

Activities to achieve the objectives

Seagrove Pavilion Trust will:

- Appoint a member of the organisation to monitor and coordinate the environmental performance of the organisation
- Communicate the environmental policy to all who use the Pavilion to ensure its effective implementation.
- Conduct periodic environmental reviews of compliance with the environmental policy and report these findings to the trustees and others.
- Encourage volunteers and members of other organisations to adopt good practices so as to improve the environmental performance of their organisation and improve its impact upon the environment.
